MEA TESTING MARCH 19 – APRIL 13

This year students in grades 3-8 will take the Maine Educational Assessment beginning on March 19th. The assessment is called eMPower ME, which is a computer-based assessment. It is very important that all our grades 3-8 students are present to take this assessment. The test sessions are between 60 and 80 minutes long and students will take a total of 7 sessions covering the following content: mathematics, reading, writing and language. We will be starting test sessions in the morning so it will be important to have students in school on time. **Please contact the office if you know that your child has a trip or an appointment scheduled during the March 19 to April 13 test window.** Once a student opens an individual test, they have to complete that test session the same day it is started. I will be trying to create a test schedule for each grade that works around special events and other planned interruptions. The results of this testing are used to review Bristol School's achievement and may inform decisions regarding curriculum, instruction and supports to benefit our students.
