## RECOGNIZING ATHLETIC AND ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT

This year Bristol Consolidated School is focusing on providing more opportunities to celebrate the growth and achievements of our students. We too often wait until something is finished to recognize the efforts and triumphs along the way. In terms of our athletic celebrations, we will be hosting three post-season events this year rather than waiting for a Booster Banquet in June. I shared at the middle school open house night that the PowerSchool reporting tool will be changing to a more specific standards-based version. This transition is currently taking place and will be used for our first trimester reports. This proficiency-based system of instruction, assessment, grading, and academic reporting is based on students demonstrating that they have learned the knowledge and skills they are expected to learn as they progress through their education. There will be a parent informational meeting about this system prior to the end of our first trimester that will share how this change supports students and how to navigate this as a parent.
