## Parking Lot Reminders for Parents

Morning drop-off occurs between 7:30-8:10. Busses arrive in the parking lot as early as 7:50 and we ask parents not to drive up to the front entrance between 7:45 and 8:15. There are two options; one is to drive up between the two rows of parked cars and drop off at the cross walk or to park your car and walk your child in at the cross walk. The bus loop is available for drop off before 7:45 or after 8:15. If dropping off while the busses are unloading, cars may not drive past the parked bus while it is unloading. The red lights will be flashing to indicate that you must wait. Cars are **not** to be parked in the bus circle at any time during the school day.

Afternoon pick-ups need to occur after the busses leave the parking lot. Students who are being picked up wait in a designated classroom until the busses leave, then they are dismissed to meet parents in the library at 2:30. We ask that you arrive between 2:20 and 2:30 and wait in the library to sign out your child. If you have to pick up your child before 2:30, please arrive prior to 2:15 and sign your child out in the office.

## PowerSchool Enrollment

A reminder to those who have not yet completed the PowerSchool enrollment- All registration, emergency information, health details, technology agreements and permissions are completed in PowerSchool. Many of these forms are mandatory for students to participate in parts of the school program, such as technology use and sports permission. If you have any questions, or are having trouble, please call the school office. If you need access to a computer, please stop in and use one at the school.

## Grades 5-8 Open House/MLTI Meeting

Please join us on Wednesday, September 11, 5:30-6:30 PM to meet with your child's teachers, attend the MLTI parent training, and hear about our plans for the 2019-2020 school year.
